Fifteen Years Ago, We Sounded the Alarm.

After a noticeable uptick in mass searches for children with autism, along with personal experiences, NAA leadership began pushing for research, which found that 49% of all children with autism are at risk of going missing. Of those who do not make it home, drowning accounts for more than 70%.

Since that time, NAA has led the way in building awareness and providing nationwide resources, education, data collection, first responder training, federal and state policy, tangible tools, and ongoing advocacy. 

- Recipient of recognition award from the National Center for Missing & Exploited Children
- Led the way passing federal legislation addressing wandering/drowning
- Commissioned to author New York Times Op-Ed piece on wandering/elopement in autism
- Twice awarded Department of Justice grants to address wandering/drowning
- Created the #SearchWaterFirst Campaign for first responders and caregivers to prevent drowning
